
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## **Biography**

- Known as the "Queen of Latin Pop" and sold more than 25 million copies of her records.

#### **Phonology/Phonetics**

 Phonetics is the study of human speech sounds and phonology is the study of sound patterning.

- In sentence 1 and 2 Thalia pronounces the word please as /plis/ so the consonant /z/ is replaced /s/
- As well in line 3 the word **them** is pronounced as /dem/ the sound of /th( $\delta$ )/ is replaced by the sound of /d/.
- In line 5 she states "it's if you have some intuition or something" the word **some** is pronounced as /sum/ rather than /s^m/.
- Also, in line 5 she pronounces the word **advantage** as /ədvæntæ战/ meaning she replaced the a for æ and the ɪ for æ.



## Morphology

• Morphology is the study of the internal structure of words.

- She drops the past tense suffixes like -ed and states verbs in present tense.
  - "Hands down and he uh surprise (surprised) me uh he surprise (surprised) me uh at the at the..." (9)
  - "Everybody had the best time, and I can (could) never forget that" (12).

## **Syntax**

• Syntax is the study of the arrangement, and the form of words.

- Line 7 is missing the determiner "an"
  - "She was sweet, fantastic, beautiful, and amazing person" (7).
  - "She was sweet, fantastic, beautiful, and an amazing person" (7).
- Line 23 is missing the conjunction "and"
  - "It's really uh empowering for women uh its fun sexy" (23).
  - "It's really uh empowering for women uh it's fun and sexy" (23).

#### **Semantics**

• Semantics is the study of the meanings of the phrases & sentences.

- Thalia uses filler words and repetition words such as "uh" and "like"
  - The filler word "uh" can be seen in sentences: 5, 7, 9, 15, 23, 25, and 26
    - Ex: "By the way uh I'm launching a new single eh on June 1st the new single is coming and I'm so excited it's really uh empowering for women uh it's fun sexy" (23).
  - The filler word "like" is present in sentences: 5, 11, 16, 24, 25, and 27
    - Ex: "...and it was like they kept telling me about this guy, and they kept telling him about this girl, me and it was like he's like who's this girl like what she does she's a singer he was like no way no no more singers, and they said to me like what he's what he does" (27).

## **Chicano English**

- Because Thalia is a native Spanish speaker and English is her second language, she does display some characteristics of Chicano English.
  - Thalia devoices some consonants like
    - the  $/t/\rightarrow$  as in it's /is/
    - the  $/z/\rightarrow$  as in please /plis/
  - Thalia substitutes the /ð/ for /de/
    - Instead of them /ðεm/ she pronounces /dem/
  - Thalia deletes past tense suffixes
    - Instead of surprised she says /surprise/

#### Conclusion

- Thalia has a great amount of English language understanding, but she does take a while to process her responses.
- She does display minor and expected errors with English being her second language.
- I learned a lot about Chicano English and how the minor semantic, morphological, phonemic, and syntactic errors in this language sample connect to Chicano English (ChE).
